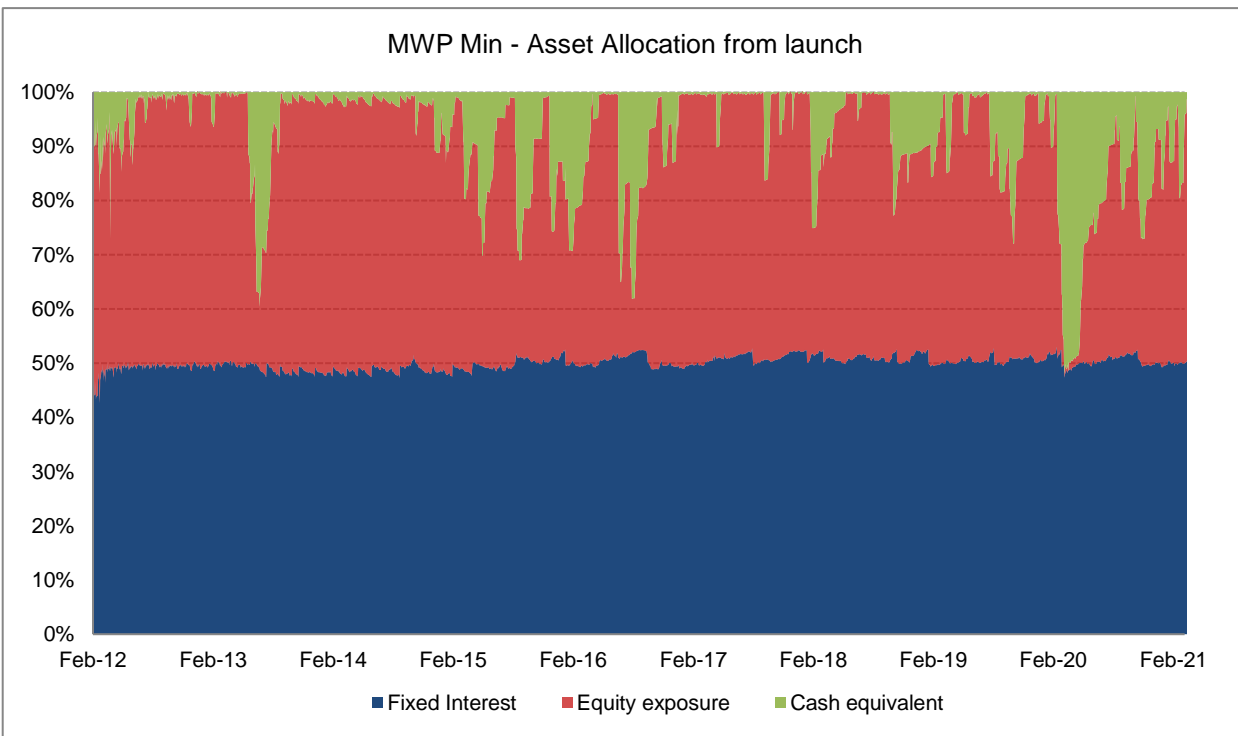
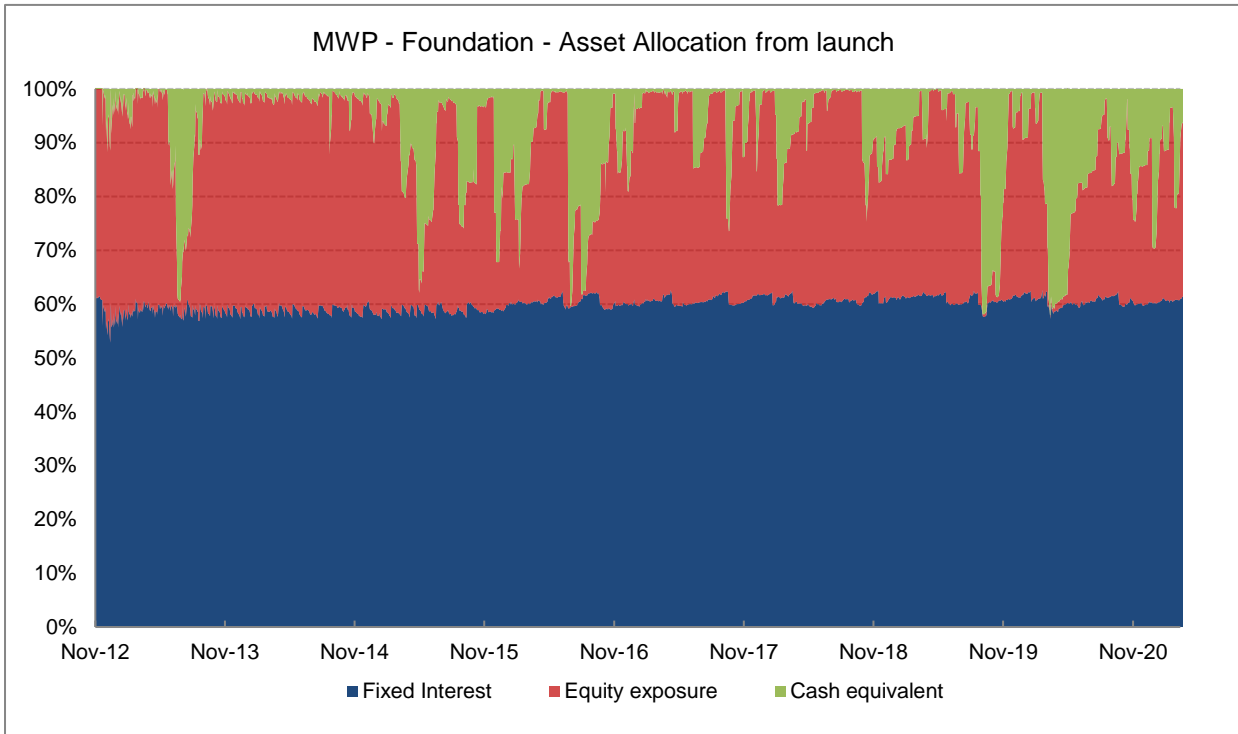
It is important to understand that the level of equity exposure can change on a daily basis depending on the level of volatility in financial markets and this will have a bearing on the potential returns available through the funds.

The table below shows the equity exposure for each of the Managed Wealth Portfolios.

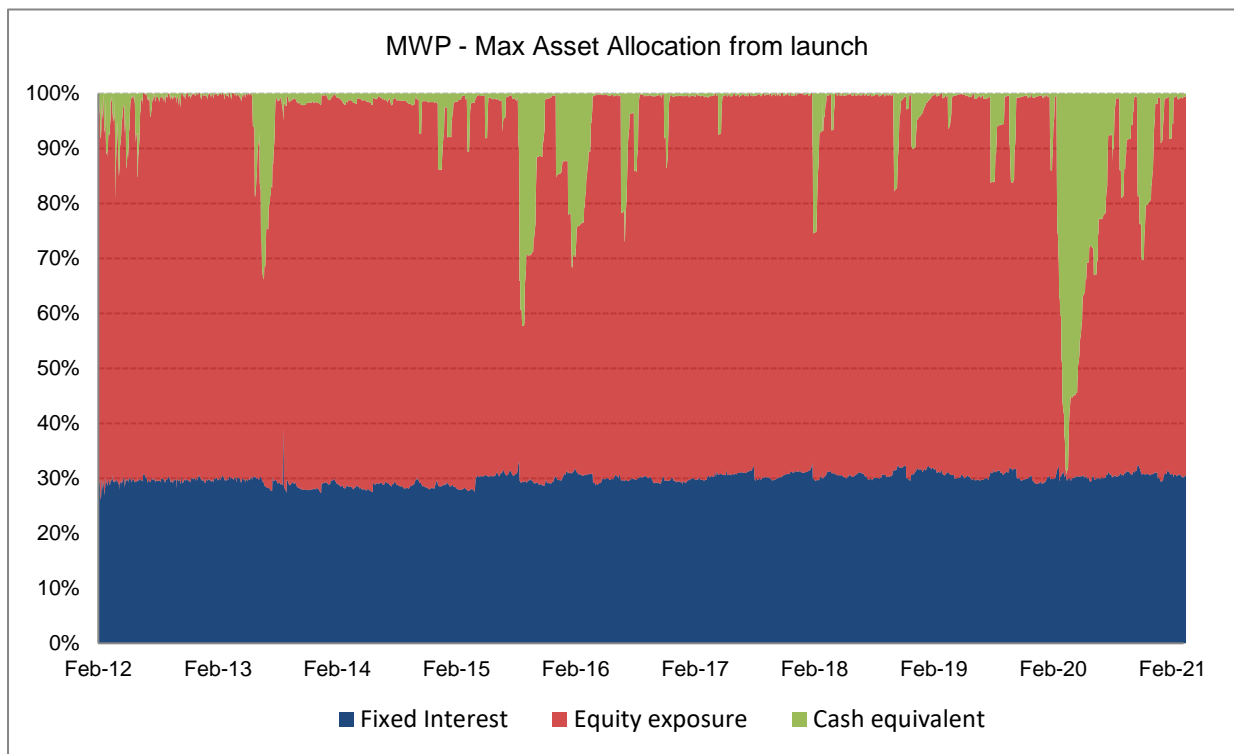
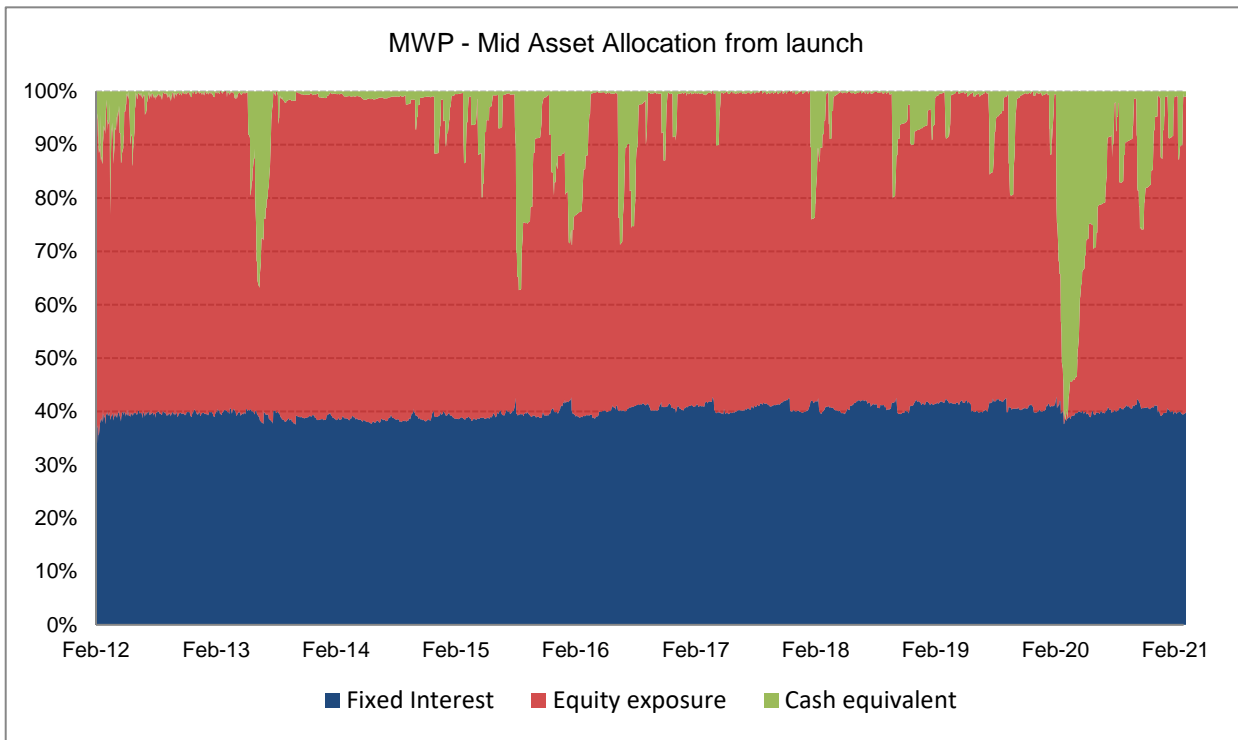
